Pattern for the Knitting (Class 76) in the Handicraft section.

This is for a Twiddlemuff, which is simply a comforter for people with anxious hands. After the Show, if you do not have anyone to give it to, it could be donated to West Suffolk Hospital via Jan Hall.

TWIDDLEMUFF PATTERN

There is no right or wrong way to make a Twiddlemuff.

The aim is to create a muff that will keep anxious hands busy and warm.

1. With double knitting wool and size 8 needles cast on 70 stitches and rib (Knit 2, purl 2) for 3 to 4 cms.
2. You can now knit any wool, any colour, and any stitch until you have an oblong shape of 35 to 40 cms.
3. Then rib again in double knitting wool for 3 to 4 cms and cast off.
4. Sew up along the long seam to make a muff.
5. Then add, inside and out, anything to twiddle – ribbon, buttons, strands of wool or cord.
