Highways Transformation Programme – A new Service Delivery Model is being introduced this summer. Suffolk Highways area teams will be based in 3 centres at Ipswich (for Babergh), Rougham (for West Suffolk) and Halesworth (for Mid and East Suffolk). The area highways contacts will change but are not yet assigned. The Brome depot will be retained under these plans. Defects/potholes/ drainage etc. should be reported in the usual way – http://highwaysreporting.suffok.gov.uk

Local Plan – The Joint Babergh and Mid Suffolk Draft Local Plan will come to the next Full Council meeting of 20th July after which it will be made available to the public for consultation over the summer. The new Plan will cover a period up to 2036 (aligned with the timescale for the Suffolk Coastal and Ipswich Local Plans).

Boundary Commission Changes - The Commission is currently consulting on plans to reduce the number of district councillors. Babergh would be reduced from 43 councillors to 31 and Mid Suffolk from 40 councillors to 34 in current proposals to achieve better electoral equivalence for voters.
