Primary School Places – Suffolk County Council received 7,544 applications from parents and carers for admission into Reception (Year R) in September 2018: 94.68% (7,143) of applicants received offers for their first preference school; and 98.85% (7,457) of applicants received an offer for one of their three preferred schools.
