Home-to-School Transport – Cabinet Decision Pending- new proposals for school and 'post-16' students will be decided by Cabinet on Tuesday 19th June. Papers are now available on Suffolk County Council's <u>website</u> under item 19-06-2018. After considering the evidence gathered during consultations, the recommendations include removing the obligation to consider cross county boundary schools and retaining support for post-16 students per the current policy. A change to nearest geographic school versus the current catchment based system is part of the new proposal.


