**COVID Vaccination Programme** – The Suffolk & NE Essex Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG) has developed a web site for Suffolk residents about the vaccine rollout, call up process, and about web based public engagement sessions SNEE NHS COVID-19 Vaccination Service website.

**Consultation: Post-16 School Travel Policy -** The consultation on proposals for 2021/ 2022 closes on **15 February 2021**. Key elements are:

- 1. Annual cost increase for travel and cost of a spare seat as previously agreed by SCC in 2018.
- 2. Post-16 policy to support students attending their nearest Suffolk school sixth form
- 3. Clarify Suffolk County Council's Independent Travel Training scheme.
