Violence Against Women Strategy Funding Announced - On April 4th, Suffolk County Council announced £350,000 to support projects offering support to Women and Girls in partnership with Suffolk Community Foundation. Suffolk Trading Standards and Port Surveillance Work – the Import Surveillance Team work to prevent dangerous goods entering the UK. It is crucial to only buy items from reputable retailers and if a price looks too good to be true, there's probably a reason why. School Places - Anyone responsible for a child born between 1 Sept. 2017 and 31 Aug. 2018 should apply for a school place immediately on [the School Admission pages](#) or by phoning the Council on 0345 600 0981. Once a place has been confirmed, any child eligible for County Council funded school travel will receive an email in May 2022 with details of how to opt-in. School Transport - Suffolk County Council will freeze travel charges for over 16s to schools and colleges from September. Fares will remain at 2021/22 levels for another 12 months. For the 2022/23 costs are £930 / yr for mainstream transport and £750 for SEND.

Fostering and Adoption Reminder - Suffolk's service still needs new foster carers and adoptive parents to come forward. These children need someone who can understand them and provide warmth, consistency and emotional support.
