To end June 2023

Income

- 1. **Footpaths Grant -376.95 / -40.4%** Second tranche of grant funding to be received. We didn't know at time of budget that the amount would go up this year, hence not a 50% variance.
- 2. Precept 12,298.00 / -50% Second tranche due at end summer
- 3. Street Cleaning Grant 0.00 / -100% We still have not recruited a pavement sweeper so no grant can be claimed for 1st quarter.

Expenditure

- 4. Admin Expenses -121.13 / -40.4% Purchase of toner cartridges £384.91
- 5. Neighbourhood Plan Grant Disbursement -3185.38 / -294.9% Two payments for consultancy work and return of unspent grant for 2022/23. This will always be 'out' because we cannot claim and return unspent grant in same financial year and we are not using income accrual accounting.
- 6. Streetlighting Repairs & Maintenance -10,294.10 / -686.3% At the time of setting the budget we had had no response from numerous chasers as to whether final phase of streetlighting upgrades had been completed. Complete radio silence from SCC for so long that we thought maybe there would be nothing further to pay but that they could not be explicit about this. Wrong. After the budget had been set we got an inkling that something would be due and sure enough not long after the invoice arrived. £2218.66 for routine maintenance and and electricity. More than budgeted amount due to recent inflationary pressures on energy prices which wiped out the savings we saw from the lamp upgrades. And £9,575.44 for the final phase of those upgrades.
